The databases available via **NSW.net** are listed in the box below.

They can be accessed **any time** at the **Cooma, Mobile** or **Bombala** Libraries.

Most of them **can be accessed via the Internet from home, school or work** (see box).

You will need a library card to do this (the barcode number is your password).

Note: the **ANZ Reference Centre** combines Australian magazines, newspapers and reference books to create the largest collection of regional full text content available to libraries and their customers in Oceania. Great for current affairs, newspaper readers, HSC and school students (primary to secondary), information on countries (including flags), biographical information, and of course general interest. **MasterFILE Premier** is similar in content to ANZ Reference, providing international coverage. **Science Reference Centre** provides access to a multitude of full text science-oriented content, and is fantastic for primary and secondary school students. It also includes biographies of scientists as well as videos and animations. The **Literary Reference Center** is great for High School English students, **NoveList** is perfect for avid readers and book groups, and **GreenFILE** provides everything environmental.
